To date, a few of our accomplishments include:

- Online publication of 90 short stories and 124 poems written by YSU students, Youngstown
  residents, and authors from around the country and world. We've accepted stories from
  as close as Boardman, Ohio and as far away as South Korea.
- Production of *Eddie Loves Debbie: The Youngstown Anthology,* a special print issue that published an additional 6 short stories and 12 poems written by YSU students and Youngstown residents.
- Creation of two free writing workshops available on YSU campus through partnerships with other student groups. The YSU Creative Writing Workshop was established in November 2014 in partnership with *Penguin Review* and the YSU Writing Center. The YSU Playwriting Workshop was established in January 2016 in partnership with YSU Alpha Psi Omega.
- Implementation of two writing contests: the Speculative Fiction Contest for Issue 8, Spring 2015 and the 10-Minute Playwriting Contest for Issue 10, Spring 2016.

Future goals include additional writing contests and special print editions of *Jenny*, as well as potential payment for issue contributors. Your sponsorship makes our continued efforts possible.
